Our Woodpeckers club offers wrap around care, before and after school for the children of Woodside Primary School during term time.

Our Club Aims to:

- Help children to develop responsibility for themselves and their actions and to become competent, confident, independent, and co-operative individuals.
- Encourage children to have a positive attitude and respect for themselves and other people.
- Promote a positive relationship with parents/carers and work in partnership with them to provide high quality play and care for their children.

Our Club is committed to providing:

- · Activities that are interesting, educational, stimulating, safe and fun.
- Activities that promote each child's all round (social, physical, moral, and intellectual) development.
- Access to a variety of indoor and outdoor facilities and equipment under safe and supervised conditions.
- Areas to read, complete homework, play sports and socialise in a safe happy environment which is inclusive and free from discrimination.

Breakfast Club Sessions - includes breakfast and drinks

Breakfast Club is open from 7:30am until 8:30am and is in Woodpeckers during term time only (not on inset days or when school is otherwise closed).

Our Breakfast club provides your child with a healthy breakfast which consists of cereals, toast, porridge, fruit, and milk. We will promote independence by encouraging the children to help prepare breakfast and to clear away after. Children then choose supervised activities including, reading, games, homework accessing our school Chromebooks and outdoor play. At 8:30am KS2 children join their class on the playground ready to line up. All other children are taken to their classrooms by a member of the Woodpeckers staff.

After School Club Session - includes drinks and healthy snacks

Option 1: 3:00pm - 4:30pm - £6.00 Option 2: 3.00pm - 5.00pm - £8.00 Option 2: 3:00pm - 5:30pm -£10.00

After school club is open during term time only (not on inset days or when school is otherwise closed).

We provide a healthy snack, including fresh fruit. Independence is promoted by encouraging the children to prepare their own snacks and to clear away after themselves. Fresh drinking water and milk are always available.

All children have opportunities to choose supervised activities including, reading, games, homework time, sports and

outdoor free play in all weathers!

The food provided is not intended as a substitute for a main evening meal. Please inform staff if your child has any dietary requirements.

Booking Woodpeckers

Please note: The school is a non-profit making organisation, and all extra funds will be used for the benefit of the children. Fees are paid in advance when booking on our school system Arbor. To book your child/ children into Woodpeckers please contact the office to be added to the Woodpeckers group in Arbor. Once added to the group bookings can then be made following the instructions below:-

- 1. On the home page on Arbor click on clubs (in the activities box).
- 2. On the next page select after school or breakfast club (this is in the 'can be registered for these clubs' box).
- 3. The next page a green button will appear 'registerfor this club' click on this box.
- 4. On the drop down choose the term or terms that you require then click next.
- 5. This will then ask what days and times you need.
- 6. You will need to do the above for breakfast and afterschool club per child.

We accept payment by card and childcare vouchers. Please contact Mrs Lavender if you wish to discuss payment terms further.

Cancelling sessions or missed sessions

Please note any sessions cancelled will not be reimbursed. Unfortunately, as a school we still have to pay for staff that are employed, and food is purchased for each session. If you have made a booking and no longer require the place you will be required to email woodpeckers to let them know, but you will still need to collect your child/children from Woodpeckers at the end of the school day. This is to ensure safeguarding protocols are followed.

Collecting your child

Children should be collected from Woodpeckers. A member of staff will meet you. If your child is to be collected by someone other than the parent/carer, you must inform us on the Woodpeckers email or mobile. If someone else should arrive to collect a child, the club will telephone the parent/carer immediately to clarify permission.

Late Collection

We understand that occasionally parents are unavoidably held up. However, late collection of your child will incur the charge of the next session, up until 5.30pm. Children who are uncollected after 5.30pm a late fee of £10 will be charged.

Policies and Procedures

Woodpeckers care provision falls within the policies and procedures of Woodside C of E Primary School. These policies are regularly reviewed and updated by the Local Governing Body and our Academy Trust- BDMAT, in line with government requirements and legislation.

We take the health, safety and welfare of our children very seriously. Our staff are Paediatric First Aid trained, have Safeguarding and Fire Safety training.

The school continually strives to provide the very best experiences for all children and Woodpeckers Club is an extension of this. If you have any feedback or concerns, you should speak initially to the Manager. We will use parental comments constructively to improve our service. However, should you feel a matter has not been resolved, **please contact Mrs Johnson**, Head Teacher via the school office.

Woodside Primary School is very proud to be able to provide this childcare service to our community. We aim to offer children a stimulating and caring environment, where children can feel happy and secure, in a familiar setting with adults they know and trust.
