Re: Y6 Boosters

From January 2025 until SATs in May (WB 12<sup>th</sup> May), we will be running 'Booster Classes' for all Year 6 children after school.

The main aim of these sessions is to help children feel confident in both their understanding of the curriculum and the process during this week of formal testing in May.

The Booster Classes will be taught in small groups of different sizes, based on ability. The teaching will be informal and relaxed and within them, children will not only revisit topics that they are unsure of in Maths and English, but also look at 'test techniques' (i.e. how questions are worded, how to answer the different types of them, what the marking system means etc.)

Booster Classes will take place on Mondays and Tuesdays between 3pm and 4pm, beginning on **Monday 20<sup>th</sup> January** and finishing on **Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> May**. Please note sessions will not run on **Monday 10<sup>th</sup>** and **Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> March** due to the KS2 residential to Whitemoor Lakes.

There will be a parent meeting on **Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> January** at 3pm where further information will be shared.

Attendance at the Booster Classes is crucial for success and we hope that we will have the full support of you as parents in ensuring that your children take up this offer. Pupils will be rewarded for their effort and commitment to their learning, in ways chosen by them.

Please give consent on arbor (under trips) by Friday 10<sup>th</sup> January ---giving permission for your child to attend the Booster Classes and can you also email the school office if you give consent to your child walking home by themselves after the class.
