Re: Forest School Curriculum

Dear Parents,

We always trying to improve our curriculum offer and what we teach our children both inside and outside of the classroom.

After supporting Miss Potter in delivering Forest School sessions after school, I felt it would be a fantastic opportunity for all children to have the opportunity to engage in a Forest School session as part of our school curriculum offer.

This is something I am trialling this academic year, with the hope to implement further sessions in the new academic year if it proves successful.

Every class will get to participate in a Forest School session all day led by Miss Potter. The class will then be accompanied by either their class teacher or myself.

On Forest School days, children will need to come into school in the following:

- P.E kit- long trousers and sleeves need to be worn due to the brambles
- Outdoor footwear wellies etc that you don't mind getting muddy
- Coat, hat, gloves weather dependant as the children will be outside all day so it will get cold. In the summer months, a sun hat, sun cream but arms and legs still need to be covered.

The following days are when each class will have their session:

Year 2	5 th March 2025
Year 3	9 th May 2025
Year 4	4 th June 2025
Year 5	25 th June 2025
Year 6	16 th June 2025
