

Re: Important Update on Baddesley and Grendon Pre School Transition

Dear Parents/Carers,

We are writing to inform you of an important change regarding **Baddesley and Grendon Pre-School**.

As of July 25, the pre-school will officially close due to the Director- Alison Scott stepping down.

However, we are pleased that from September the Nursery is going to become part of the Birmingham Diocesan MAT, operating as part of Woodside Primary School, which will give the provision a much more secure future.

This transition is designed to **ensure continuity and stability** for all children currently enrolled, as well as provide **additional places to support the village's growth**.

To make this as smooth as possible:

- All current staff will be transferred under TUPE to Woodside Primary and become BDMAT employees, ensuring no member of staff loses their employment.
- The new nursery will be fully integrated into Woodside Primary, allowing for a seamless transition for both children and staff.
- The nursery will continue to serve as a **key part of the local community**, maintaining the high standards and nurturing environment that families have valued for years.
